Dear Parishioners,

In today's world we see a radical difference between the way of Christ and the way of the world. The disciples who represented the community used values of the kingdom and they were treated as being radically different from the ways of the world. What are Christian moral and ethical values? What does God require of us? How can I obey the Word of God?
